

# **International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses**

## **Privacy statement**

International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

### **Collection of your Personal Information**

International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites. There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses . This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses Web site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

## **Use of your Personal Information**

International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses collects and uses your personal information to operate the International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses Web site and deliver the services you have requested. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses and its affiliates. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses , and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent. International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses , in order to determine what International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

## **Use of Cookies**

The International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses pages, or register with International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses site or services, a cookie helps International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses Web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the International Network of Spinal Cord Injury Nurses features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. ## **Security of your Personal Information**
